We are looking for motivated people to facilitate our afterschool children's program for the 2011-2012 school year for children ranging in age from 6-12 years old.

Responsibilities:

- Participate in training, orientation and schedule staff meetings
- Abide by the policies and procedures of St. Alban's Boys' and Girls' Club
- Take day to day instruction from supervisors
- Facilitate a dynamic program that will be creative, challenging, fun, and memorable for children and youth and that also meets program requirements
- Ensure the safety and security of the participants and respond to critical incidents as outlined in our policies and procedures
- Provide guidance and support to program volunteers
- Complete appropriate paperwork in a timely manner (incident reports, program plans, stats reports, and evaluations) and reports to Site Coordinators and Program Coordinators on a regular basis
- Attend regularly scheduled meetings
- Maintain positive professional relationships with peers, participants, parents, and partners
- Assist in the evaluation of program at the end of the school year.

Qualifications:

- Minimum 16 years of age
- Outgoing, leadership skills and enthusiastic
- Prior experience working/volunteering in a program setting
- Creative programming ideas and experience bringing diverse groups of children together in a recreational, social, or educational setting
- Standard first aid qualifications (acquired before first day of training)
- Must be a team player and be able to work well with others
- Experience working within culturally-diverse communities including an understanding of visible and invisible dimensions of diversity
- Ability to work from an anti-racist/anti-oppression based approach/framework
